Phonics Screening Check in June

Phonics is used to teach children to segment and blend for spelling and reading

Year 2 Grammar

Children who did not pass the phonics screening check will resit at the end of the year.

Daily spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG) lessons

The SPaG test is part of Year 2 SATs, and aspects are to be included in children's written work.
