Dear Parents and Guardians,

**Year 1 Science Trip to The Wild Board Park, Chipping.**

I am writing to tell you about a forthcoming educational trip on Monday, 19<sup>th</sup> March. The venue for this visit is The Wild Boar Park, Chipping. The aim of this visit is to complement the pupils' studies in Science. The trip includes chick stroking, lamb feeding, a guided tour around the park and a tractor ride around the park.

The coach will leave school at 09:00. We will be back at school by 15:30. The party will number forty-one pupils. I will be leading and supervising the visit with assistance from Miss Tiffany, Mrs Isap and four other adults. Should you wish to be a parent helper please indicate on the reply slip provided. We will contact those parents selected by Wednesday, 14<sup>th</sup> March.

The pupils will be led by qualified instructors at the centre. The risks associated with the visit have been assessed in accordance with school policy. During the visit, normal school rules regarding acceptable conduct and behaviour will apply.

As the trip will be largely outdoors, full school PE tracksuits should be worn with appropriate footwear (trainers or wellington boots depending on the weather). Waterproof jackets will also be needed; although indoor activities will take place in the case of inclement weather.

I will be taking the school's mobile phone (**07957 700045**) with me for use in case of an emergency. Mr Barrand will act as the emergency contact at school and can be contacted on 01254 686311.

A charge of approximately £12 is required to cover the cost of the visit. This will be available for you to view and pay via your Scopay account in due course. A school packed meal will be provided. I would advise your son/daughter to bring a bottle of water. Healthy snacks will be provided as they would in school however own snack may be brought instead.

In cases of hardship it may, under certain strict conditions, be possible for the school to subsidise the trip, but this will mean that personal financial information would be required. If you wish to discuss this, please contact me as a matter of urgency.
