**PSHEE Lessons: Year 2 Relationship Education**

As part of our Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education, the children in Year 2 will be covering a five week 'Friends & Family' topic based on a unit of work written by Wiltshire's Personal Development Education Team. In Year 2 this work will focus on relationships with friends and family. It further develops learning about issues such as, growing & changing, personal hygiene and germs.

The expected outcomes are:

- **I can** name and label parts of the body
- **I know** that my body belongs to me.
- **I can** tell you how I am growing and changing.
- **I know** why I must wash my hands after certain activities.
- **I know** whose job it is to help us wherever we are.

Key vocabulary that will be discussed includes: human, body, head, face, eyes, ears, leg, foot, toes, knee, stomach, bottom, chest, shoulder, arm, elbow, hand, fingers, bones, skeleton, ok, not ok, feel, touch, NO!, STOP!, tell, grow, change, young, old, baby, toddler, child, teenager, grown up, same, different, born, birth, wash, hands, dirty, clean, germs, help, safe and jobs.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that this work will begin in the next week. You may find that your child starts asking questions about the topic at home, or you might want to take the opportunity to talk to your child about issues such as those above before the work is covered in school.
