Dear Parents and Guardians,

Changing after Games

In response to entirely justified parental concerns about the inconvenience when buses from Lammack are missed or return coaches have to take detours or wait for pupils returning from games, we have reviewed our arrangements in order to make things smoother and, we hope, ensure that these frustrations are reduced.

Thus, on a trial basis, from Monday 8th February, we are going to relax the rule concerning dress when pupils return from their afternoon games session at the Harisson Playing Fields at Lammack.

The games staff have found, with the increased numbers of pupils in the school, that getting everyone changed back into school uniform after games is taking significantly longer than it used to. The result is that the amount of time actually doing games is being squeezed.

We want QEGS pupils to continue to look smart, of course, so when they return to school they must wear their blazer on top of their games kit. On occasions, if the weather is poor and there is mud or it is excessively cold, it may be necessary to have pupils getting changed at Lammack as they always have done, in which case we will adjust the timings so they finish slightly earlier and are returned to school.

We will review this new routine later in the term to see if it is having the desired effect and pupils are indeed having more time playing games, as well as looking acceptably smart when they return to school.
