Dear Parents & Carers,

PSHEE Lessons: Year 3 Relationship Education

As part of our Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education, the children in KS2 will be covering a five week 'Friends & Family' topic based on a unit of work written by Wiltshire's Personal Development Education Team. In Year 3 this work will focus on relationships with friends and family. It further develops learning about sensitive issues such as personal hygiene.

The expected outcomes are:

- **I can** tell when something is my fault and something is not my fault.
- **I know** that there are different forms of families.
- **I have thought about** my skills and achievements.
- **I can** list the parts of my body that need to be kept clean.
- **I can** help people to make them feel that they belong.
- **I know** that I can say 'no' when I need to.

Key vocabulary that will be discussed includes: family names (Mum, Dad, Brother, Sister, Aunt, Uncle, Stepfather, Stepmother), valuable, adopted, extended family, special, unique, strengths, abilities, development, personal, bacteria, regularly, hygiene, infection, decay, greasy, dirty, soap/toothpaste/water, different, the same/ similar, belong, groups, in common, abilities, emotions (sad/ upset/ lonely/ isolated), friend / peer, pressure, sensible/ not sensible and risky.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that this work will begin in the next two weeks. You may find that your child starts asking questions about the topic at home, or you might want to take the opportunity to talk to your child about issues such as those above before the work is covered in school.
